

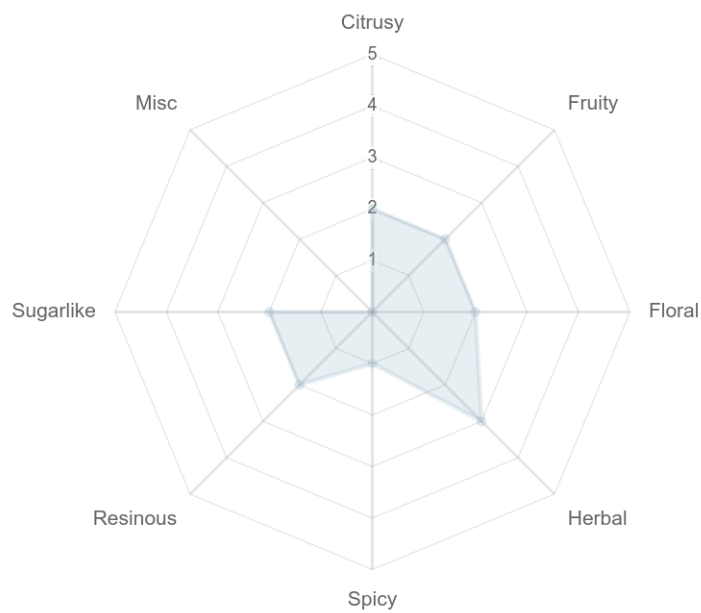


FIRST GOLD
