

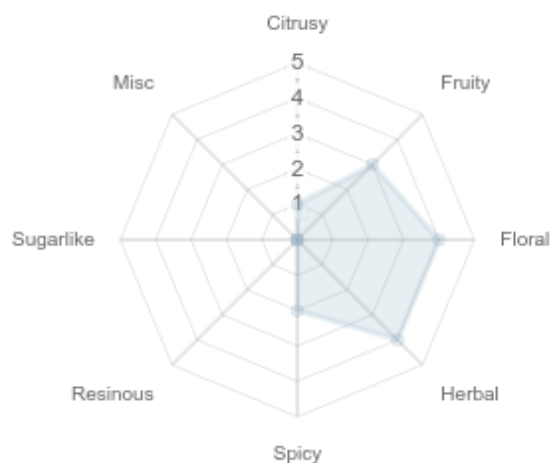


# STYRIAN GOLDING (CELEIA)
